****NO CURB-SIDE HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH COLLECTION THIS SPRING****

****BRUSH AND YARD WASTE WILL REMAIN CURB-SIDE****

Properties paying the "Garbage" fee on their monthly utility bills are eligible to utilize the following drop-off site. Owners and tenants of properties not paying the fee should contact their regular waste hauler for service.

LOCATION

In front the DPW building on 125 N. Stephenson Ave, enter the site from Fleshiem Street behind True Value hardware.

DAYS & HOURS

Drop-off will begin May 11, 2017. Drop-off site will be open for three days.

Hours, 7:30am-3:00pm, Friday, Saturday

Hours, 7:30am-7:00pm, Thursday

Acceptable material limited to two (2) pickup loads per day. This drop-off site is not available to commercial haulers.

A Driver's License and a City utility bill with garbage fee will be required as proof of residency for admittance. You must **sign in** with the attendant as you enter the site.

RENTERS/TENANTS

Residents in rental units who do not have a utility bill in their name must go through their landlord to file a form with the Public Works Dept. listing the tenants eligible to use the site. Form is included – additional forms available at DPW

HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH DROP-OFF

The drop-off is limited to toys, tools, furniture, (appliances Freon free must be tagged), old clothing, shoes, books, draperies, carpets, decorations, (**remodeling waste** less than two pickup truck loads per day, rocks and masonry must be kept separate), and other minor household items.

REMODELING WASTE

If you are doing major remodeling or re-roofing your house, contact a Waste disposal company to set up a dumpster service on site at your cost.

APPLIANCES & WHITE GOODS

Appliances and White Goods include all appliances, and water heaters. Appliances using any regulated refrigerant must bear an appropriate technician's certificate of compliance certifying that the refrigerant has been recaptured.

DONATION OF ITEMS FOR REUSE

Items that can be reused, such as working appliances or furniture free of defects, can be donated to the ReStore. For more information on donations, **please contact the ReStore at 774-2867**. The ReStore provides free pick-up for any item accepted for a donation. **The ReStore will not accept computer equipment any more**

COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

- Computers, Laptops, Network Equipment, Computer Parts, Software, Flat-panel Screens, Monitors, Printers and Scanners.
- Computers and their peripherals (working and not working) can be recycled at the **Goodwill Store** located at **South Stephenson Ave, Iron Mountain, Michigan 49801**. You are responsible for removing all data from hard drives and other storage media before donating to Goodwill.

METAL ITEMS

Metal items will be separated for recycling.

COMPOST SITE

Compost site will be open, compost and branches must be separated.

FOLLOWING ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE DROP-OFF SITE

- Liquid or hazardous wastes.
- Oil, paint or anti-freeze
- Freon containing appliances
- Compressed gas tanks
- Tires
- Regular garbage, including food items.
- Batteries
